PLEASE READ INFORMATION BELOW:

1. **Registration Fee of \$300.00 per family and & Diocesan Fee of \$12.00 per student must be paid in full at the time of registration.** Registration Fee is non-refundable. Post-dated checks are not accepted.
2. Family discount for more than one child does not apply to Pre-K.
3. St. Edward's fiscal year is from July to April. Please refer to Financial Policy for details regarding monthly payments.
Payment options are as follows:
 - a. Payment in full on or before July 15th.
 - b. Fees paid in full on or before July 15th, tuition divided into TEN monthly installments.
 - c. Tuition and fees divided into TEN monthly installments.
4. The maximum payment per family for the Building and Maintenance fee is \$200.00 per year.
5. A limited amount of tuition assistance is available from the school. Please apply in the Business Office when registering for the 2009-2010 school year. Parents/guardians may want to inquire with the pastor of their parish about assistance. Again, tuition assistance is limited; therefore not guaranteed.

Please Note: The option to split or not split fees into TEN monthly installments is only available at the time of registration. Once payment schedules are set up they WILL NOT be changed. If fees are spread over 10 months and a student is withdrawn during the school year, ALL FEES MUST BE PAID IN FULL upon withdrawal.
